

Where is Madagascar the energy hub

Article Overview

Madagascar is an island nation off the southeastern coast of Africa with a developing energy sector heavily reliant on bioenergy and facing significant electricity access challenges.

Geographical Location

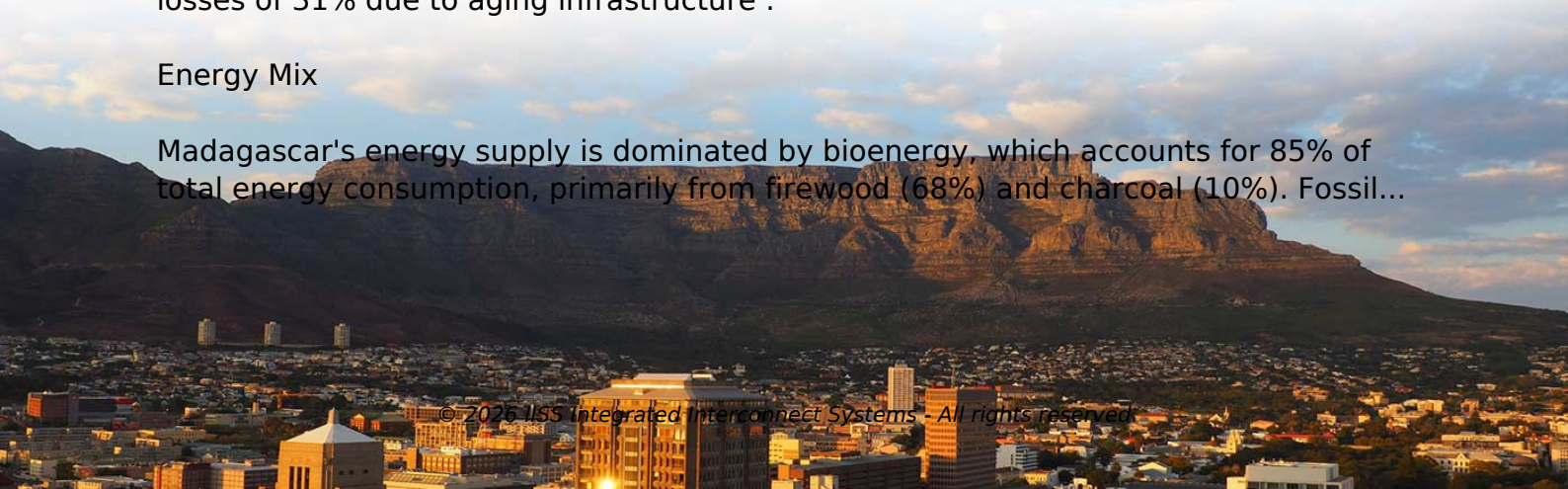
Madagascar is the world's fourth-largest island, located approximately 400 kilometers (250 miles) east of Mozambique in the Indian Ocean. It includes the main island of Madagascar and numerous smaller peripheral islands. The capital and largest city is Antananarivo, and the country has a population of nearly 32 million people .

Energy Access and Infrastructure

Madagascar faces low electricity access, with only 36% of the population connected, and rural areas are particularly underserved, with just 7% having electricity . The national electricity system is fragmented into three separate high-voltage grids: the Antananarivo Interconnected Network (covering 70% of consumption), the Fianarantsoa Interconnected Grid, and the Toamasina Interconnected Grid. These grids are largely concentrated in urban areas, and the country suffers from system losses of 31% due to aging infrastructure .

Energy Mix

Madagascar's energy supply is dominated by bioenergy, which accounts for 85% of total energy consumption, primarily from firewood (68%) and charcoal (10%). Fossil...
