

Which cable tray should the 48V power cable in the computer room run on

A ladder-type or wire mesh (basket) cable tray is generally recommended for 48V power cables in a computer room, ensuring proper ventilation, ampacity, and NEC compliance.

Tray Type Selection

Ladder Tray: Ladder trays consist of two side rails connected by rungs, providing excellent ventilation and heat dissipation, which is crucial for power cables carrying current, even at low voltage like 48V . They allow easy installation, removal, and support for heavier cable bundles, making them suitable for computer room power distribution. **Wire Mesh (Basket) Tray:** Wire mesh trays are lightweight and flexible, commonly used in data centers for low-voltage power and communication cables . They provide good airflow and are ideal for routing 48V power cables alongside network or signal cables while maintaining separation. **Avoid Solid-Bottom Trays:** Solid-bottom trays restrict airflow, reduce ampacity, and are generally used only where cables need protection from debris or fluids . For a computer room, this is usually unnecessary and may require derating the cable's current-carrying capacity .

NEC Compliance and Cable Separation

- 48V power cables are considered low-voltage (under 600V), so they can share a tray with other low-voltage cables if fill limits are respected .
- Ensure proper cable fill according to NEC Table 392.22(A) to avoid overheating
