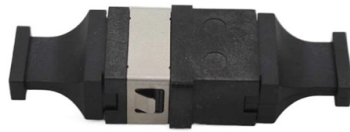


Why do switches connect to fiber optic cables

Fiber supports higher bandwidth, allowing more data to flow simultaneously. This is critical for modern networks that require rapid data transfer and future-proofing, as fiber infrastructure can accommodate upgrades without replacing the cables
